



Specialized Device Cleaners



I am looking for some self-motivated, cheerful people to work on a major, long-term contract in Northeast Calgary – close to Barlow Trail and 27th Avenue NE (right on CTS Bus Route #32). I need to hire people who are great working in a team environment and/or on their own, cleaning various electronic devices, such as terminals, printers, pinpads, cords, power packs and other similar devices.

You need no experience, besides common sense, patience, be detail-oriented and a have good work ethic. We will train you from scratch on the best way to clean each device, so that you become proficient in your job.

Your remuneration is based on piece meal, which means you get paid on your productivity. The better you are, the more money you will make. *{I do not believe that two people working side by side and one producing more than the other should be paid the same. The better producer should be paid more.}*

You are guaranteed minimum wage; however, **our experienced cleaners generally make between \$12 and \$16/hour – often more.** Our goal is to have you making at least \$10/hour by the end of your first week or 2. That's where you come in. We need people who want to get better and better at what they do.

We are VERY flexible with the hours. You will start out initially working from 9:00am to 3:00pm. Once we feel that you are proficient enough to work on your own, then you work as much as you want between 7:30am and 4:00pm. You can come early and leave early or come late and leave late – or stay the whole day. It's up to you – as long as we know your plans in advance.

If you need time off for your family, we can accommodate you. Family is very important and if your kids need you, for example, at their school for a function, then that is where you should be. There may be the odd "crunch times" when we will need everyone to be in, but that will not happen very often – if at all.

This is a perfect job for a mom of school aged children, who wants to be there when they go to school and be back home when they return from school.

It is also a good job for anyone looking for a job that's "easy on the brain" and not too physically taxing. The key thing is attitude. You do need to have pretty good hand co-ordination and be able to clean items with your hands. It is generally a sit down job, though you do need to get up to put your finished work on the shelf. Some of the people we have working now prefer to stand while they work – it's up to each individual.

I do prefer full time staff, but I will consider part time for the right person. You can come in any day(s) of the standard work week (Monday to Friday) for at least 3 or 4 hours... That way it will keep their training fresh and they get to know the job better.
